How To Use This Curriculum

About this Curriculum

Hebrews 6:1-3 says: So let us stop going over the basic teachings about Christ again and again. Let us go on instead and become mature in our understanding. Surely we don't need to start again with the fundamental importance of repenting from [dead works] and placing our faith in God. You don't need further instruction about baptisms, the laying on of hands, the resurrection of the dead, and eternal judgment. And so, God willing, we will move forward to further understanding (NLT).

Salvation is the starting point of a lifelong journey of living for God. Saved children, like all adult believers, need to grow in living for God. Part of the growth process is to be grounded in the basic teachings about Christ, and these are: repenting from [dead works], placing their faith in God, instruction about baptisms, laying on of hands, resurrection of the dead, and eternal judgment.

Grow In Living For God Curriculum is designed to teach children these basic teachings about Christ and encourage them towards personal application of the teachings in their lives. Through this exciting Bible-based curriculum, with the help of the Holy Spirit, children will be grounded in their salvation and God's Word, and grow in living for God.

Teaching the Lessons

Grow In Living For God curriculum is divided into 6 sections based on the basic teachings about Christ in Hebrews 6:2 with an introductory lesson on growing in living for God. Section 1 has 3 lessons on repenting from dead works, section 2 teaches the importance of placing their faith in God in 8 lessons, section 3 with 4 lessons instructs on the 3 main types of baptism, section 4 contains 5 lessons on the laying on of hands, section 5 examines the different types of resurrection of the dead, and section 6 comprises a lesson each on eternal judgement and rewards.

Based on over 30 years of experience in teaching children, I have discovered that it is more effective to teach a lesson twice and by the same teacher. The teacher can review the lesson with the children and follow-up appropriately based on their responses. Also, the message of the lesson is strengthened in the hearts and minds of the children.

Lesson Outline: A suggested order for using the curriculum to teach the class is:

- Review the previous lesson;
- Introduce the lesson to engage the children;
- Teach the Bible story and life application interactively;
- Make an altar call when applicable;
- Use the discussion to personalize the message;
- Pray with the children;
- Get the children to learn and recite the memory verse incorporating actions; and
- Have the children do activities to reinforce the lesson.

Bible Text: Regardless of the age group being taught, you must read the Bible text in preparation. For this curriculum to be an effective tool in transforming the lives of children, there is the need for you as the teacher to study the Bible text with the help of the Holy Spirit. As you do this, trust that God will grant you an understanding of the Bible passage and make the Word come alive on the inside of you to minister to the children.

Memory Verse: Different Bible versions are used for clarity to ensure the children understand the Scripture. Be sure to teach the memory verse word-perfect to the children. Where necessary, explanations have been provided for the memory verses. It is helpful to incorporate actions or even turn it into a song with a catchy tune as you recite the memory verse with the children. Repetition is key to helping them retain the memory verse.

Truth of God's Word: The truth of God's Word sums up what you are teaching the children to believe and act upon from God's Word about the lesson. The memory verse, Bible story, life application and discussion build upon the truth of God's Word.

Introduction: Start the lesson by getting the children to discuss the introduction. This helps to engage the children. Round up this session by linking their discussion to what you are teaching them on the lesson.

Bible Story: The Bible story is taken from the *Easy To Read Version* Bible and modified to allow for smooth comprehension. In teaching the children the Bible story, make it as interactive as possible. For example: "When God sent an angel to tell Joseph that Mary would give birth to the Son of God, what do you think Joseph said or did?" If possible, try to get them to do some role playing of the Bible characters as well. Incorporate as many variety of interactive activities as possible to interest them without distracting from the message you are teaching.

Life Application: This is the personal application of God's Word to the children to encourage them to act on what they have learned. As much as possible, personalize the teaching to the children in your class. Encourage participation in form of questions and comments from the children.

Discussion: This serves to involve the children to find out and enhance their understanding of the lesson. In addition, it aids the children process aloud their personalization of the Bible lesson. Discussion points are given. Sometimes, the discussion for the junior and senior age groups are different based on their comprehension levels. Where appropriate, use the children's activity books to guide the discussion.

Notes: Space for taking notes during your preparation is provided for each lesson. Sometimes, notes are added to help you teach the lesson more effectively.

"And what about the seed that fell on the good ground? That is like the people who hear God's teachings with a good, honest heart. They obey it and patiently produce a good crop, that is, do the good things God wants His people to do."	
Life Application	
Based on Jesus' story, the seed that fell on the good ground is the type of believer God wants you to be. For you to be a believer who hears God's teachings with a good, honest heart and obeys it, so that you can grow in living for God by doing the good things God wants you to do.	
God's Word says: Be like newborn babies who are thirsty for the pure spiritual milk that will help you grow—1Peter 2:2 (CEV). After you believe in Jesus to be saved, you become born-again, that is, a baby believer. As a newborn baby needs milk to live and grow, you need the spiritual milk which is the Word of God to live and grow in living for God. In other words, you should know and obey God's Word especially the basic teachings about Christ to grow in living for God.	
Hebrews 6:1-3 says: So let us stop going over the basic teachings about Christ again and again. Let us go on instead and become mature in our understanding. Surely we don't need to start again with the fundamental importance of repenting from [dead works] and placing our faith in God. And so, God willing, we will move forward to further understanding (NLT).

Being a believer, it is necessary for you to know these basic teachings about Christ. However, for these teachings to help you grow in living for God, you must put them into practice in your life, that is, obey them.	
Knowing and obeying these basic teachings about Christ will do the following for you:	
You will be very sure that you are saved.	
You will also be sure about God's Word.	
You will grow in living for God daily.	
So know and obey the basic teachings about Christ to grow in living for God. Therefore, ask the Holy Spirit to help you.	
Discussion	
Encourage the class to share about anything they know on repenting from [dead works], placing their faith in God, instruction about baptisms, laying on of hands, resurrection of the dead, and eternal judgment.


