Before your mom went out, she told you to tidy your room. You decided to play your video game first, and your grandma visited, cleaned the room and left. Now your mom is back, sees the clean room and tells you what a great job you did.

While you and your friend were playing, you broke a plate. After your friend left, your mom sees the broken plate and is upset. She asks you who broke the plate.

What Would You Do Like Jesus?

You are going into a store, and you see a man coming out who drops a five-dollar. You call out to him, but he doesn't hear you and he gets on the bus.

What Would You Do Like Jesus?

As you walk up to your friends, you hear them laughing and making fun of another child. They want you to laugh with them.

What Would You Do Like Jesus?

On Christmas morning, you and your sister open your gifts. Your sister gets what she wanted but your gift is not what you told your parents you wanted.

What Would You Do Like Jesus?

Scene 1

Characters: Angel Gabriel, Mary, Joseph and Jesus.

Here is Mary and Joseph. Mary is a virgin girl who lives in Nazareth, a town in Galilee. She is engaged to marry Joseph who is from the family of David.

Joseph goes out and Mary is alone. An angel Gabriel comes to her. Mary is very surprise to see him.

Angel Gabriel says, "Greetings! The Lord is with you; you are very special to him."

Wow! Mary is very confused about what the angel says. Mary wonders, "Hmm, what does this mean?"

Angel Gabriel says to Mary, "Don't be afraid, Mary, because God is very pleased with you. Listen! You will become pregnant and have a baby boy. You will name him Jesus."

(Have Jesus come and stand on the other side of you and direct the class attention to him.)

This is Jesus. He will be great. People will call him the Son of the Most High God and the Lord God will make him king like his ancestor David. He will rule over the people of Jacob forever; his kingdom will never end.

(Motion for Jesus to leave and turn the class attention back to Mary and the angel.)

Mary says to the angel, "How will this happen? I am still a virgin."

The angel spread his hands over Mary and answers, "The Holy Spirit will come to you, and the power of the Most High God will cover you. The baby will be holy and will be called the Son of God. God can do anything!"

Mary puts her hands across her chest, nods and says, "I am the Lord's servant. Let this thing you have said happen to me!"

Then the angel goes away. And so does Mary.

Scene 2

Characters: Angel, pregnant Mary, Joseph and Jesus.

Props: Throw pillow tied with a sheet for pregnant Mary.

(Have pregnant Mary and Joseph stand on opposite sides of you. Turn the class attention to pregnant Mary)

Everyone look, this is Mary. She is now pregnant just as God told angel Gabriel to tell her. Wow, Isn't God powerful?

(Motion for pregnant Mary to leave and turn the class attention to Joseph.)

Now here is Joseph. Remember he is engaged to Mary. He just learned that Mary is expecting a baby. She is pregnant by the power of the Holy Spirit. He is worried, see him walking up and down, his hand on his chin wondering what to do. Now he is tired from all that thinking, so he lays down to sleep.

Here comes an angel from the Lord to talk to Joseph in his dream.

The angel says, "Joseph, son of David, don't be afraid to accept Mary to be your wife. The baby inside her is from the Holy Spirit. She will give birth to a son. You will name him Jesus."

(Have Jesus come and stand on the other side of you and direct the class attention to him.)

This is Jesus. God says for Joseph to give him the name Jesus because he will save his people from their sins.

(Motion for Jesus to leave and turn the class attention back to Joseph and the angel.)

The angel finishes his message and leave.

Then Joseph gets up and goes to bring Mary. He obeys God and marries her.

Scene 3

Characters: Augustus Caesar, servant, people*, hotel keeper, 2 children holding the sheet for the screen, Mary and Joseph.

Optional: Animals*.

Props: Wrapped up doll to be baby Jesus, throw pillow tied with a sheet for pregnant Mary, a sheet to act as a screen.

Augustus Caesar the king calls his servant. He tells his servant that that everyone's name must be put on a list. Then he orders his servant to go to the people in the countries that were under Roman rule.

The servant leaves the king and goes to the people. The servant tells the people what the king ordered. So everyone leaves to travel to their own hometowns to have their name put on the list.

Here comes Joseph and pregnant Mary. They are leaving Nazareth where they live to go to Bethlehem in Judea which is Joseph's hometown. When Joseph and Mary get to Bethlehem, it is time for her to have the baby.

Joseph and Mary do not have a house in Bethlehem, so they go to a hotel. Joseph knocks on the door and the hotel keeper answers. The hotel keeper tells him there is no room for them.

Joseph takes Mary with him to a manger where the animals are kept. Mary goes in to have her baby.

(Have Mary go behind the screen to remove the throw pillow and pick up the wrapped baby Jesus doll.)

Here comes Mary with baby Jesus. Both Joseph and Mary are happy that baby Jesus is born.

Scene 4

Characters: Angel, shepherds* angel choir*, Mary, Joseph and baby Jesus.

Optional: Sheep*.

Props: Wrapped up doll to be baby Jesus.

That night, some shepherds are sitting out in the fields near Bethlehem watching their sheep. An angel of the Lord appears to them, and the glory of the Lord is shining around them.

The shepherds become very afraid. And the angel says to them, "Don't be afraid. I have some very good news for you—news that will make everyone happy."

The shepherds stop being afraid, and they are getting excited.

The angel continued telling them, "Today your Savior was born in David's town. He is the Messiah, the Lord. This is how you will know him: You will find a baby wrapped in pieces of cloth and lying in a feeding box."

Then a huge army of angels from heaven join the first angel.

All the angels start praising God, saying, "Praise God in heaven, and on earth let there be peace to the people who please him."

The angels leave the shepherds and go back to heaven.

The shepherds say to each other, "Let's go to Bethlehem and see this great event the Lord has told us about."

And the shepherds leave their field.

Here is Mary and Joseph with the baby Jesus. The shepherds come running in. When the shepherds see the baby, they are so excited to see the Savior of the world. And the shepherds started praising God and thanking him for everything they had seen and heard. It was just as the angel had told them.





News Reporting Example

John 2:1-11 Jesus Turns Water into Wine at the Wedding in Cana.

Newscaster: Our next news item is on how Jesus turned water into wine at a wedding in Cana. Jesus and His followers were invited to the wedding. And so was Jesus' mother, Mary. At the wedding there was not enough wine, so Jesus' mother said to him, "They have no more wine." Jesus saw that there were six large empty stone water pots nearby. So Jesus called the servants and said to them, "Fill the water pots with water." So the servants filled them to the top.

Then Jesus said to them, "Now dip out some water and take it to the man in charge of the feast." The servants did what Jesus said. Then the man in charge tasted it, but the water had become wine. He called the bridegroom and said to him, "People always serve the best wine first. But you have saved the best wine until now." This was the first of all the miracles Jesus did.

Now let's go to our reporter who is in Cana at the wedding venue.

Reporter: Hi. My name is ... and I am here at the wedding venue where Jesus turned water into wine. Standing with me is ... one of the servants who filled the water pots with water. Please tell our viewers what happened exactly.

Servant: There were a lot of guests at the wedding and our master did not buy enough wine, so we ran out of wine to serve the guests. As I was talking with the other servants about what we should do

next, there was a woman standing next to us listening. Then she told us not to worry that she will do something to help. She left and came back with Jesus and she told us to do whatever He tells us. I thought He was going to give us money to buy more wine. Imagine my surprise when he tells us to fill the water pots with water.

Reporter: Did you know what Jesus was going to do with the water pots filled with water?

Servant: No, none of us had any idea.

Reporter: When He told you to take some water to the man in charge of the feast, what did you think?

Servant: I thought Jesus was crazy. But I am a servant, so I had to obey Him and do what I was told.

Reporter: So when did you know that Jesus had turned the water into wine?

Servant: When the master of ceremony drank from the cup and told the bridegroom that he had saved the best wine for now. I couldn't believe what I was hearing, I had to taste the "water" for myself. It was the best wine I ever had. It is a miracle!
